## **Background:**

Carter BloodCare intends to implement the use of a new whole blood collection bag with the goal of meeting the expanded demand for Low Titer Group O Whole Blood (LTOWB). This collection kit contains citrate-phosphate-dextrose-adenine (CPDA-1) anticoagulant-preservative solution and extends product dating for LTOWB from 21 days to 35 days. The tentative go-live date is scheduled for August 27, 2024.

## Impact to Clients:

- LTOWB will be labeled with a 35-day expiration date. This replaces the existing 21-day product. LTOWB remains non-leukoreduced.
- CPDA-1 leukoreduced red blood cells will be labeled with a 35-day expiration date.
- Citrate-Phosphate-Dextrose (CPD) unit production and availability remains unchanged.
- New product codes are required and are listed below for your reference.
- A thirty-day notice will be provided as required per the blood service agreement should a fee increase be necessary.
