Dr. Laurie Sutor, who began her role at BloodCare in 1994, will be retiring as Carter BloodCare's Chief Medical Officer at the end of August. Dr. Sutor has played a major role in ensuring the successes of Carter BloodCare. Nationally, her many memberships on committees that define the scope of blood banking and transfusion medicine have ensured that our blood program's influence is extensive. Her faculty appointment at the <u>University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center</u> has ensured a strong relationship with academia.

Dr. Richard Gammon will be taking Dr. Sutor's place as Chief Medical Officer on August 29, 2024. He is currently Medical Director at <u>One Blood</u> in Orlando, Florida, a position he has held for the last twelve years. Dr. Gammon has a number of academic appointments and he is also an AABB assessor, with international responsibilities. He has played prominent roles in national and international organizations, including <u>America's Blood Centers</u>, the <u>Association for the Advancement of Blood & Biotherapies</u>, and the <u>International Society of Blood Transfusion</u>. He is widely published and has been principal investigator on studies that have explored many different aspects of blood banking and transfusion medicine.
