Background

Proprietary laboratory analyses (PLA) codes are an addition to the CPT[®] code set approved by the American Medical Association CPT Editorial Panel. PLA codes are alpha-numeric billing codes with a corresponding descriptor for labs and/or manufacturers that want to specifically identify their test.

Impact to Clients:

- Carter BloodCare uses the ID Core XT[™] assay to perform molecular red blood cell typing.
- The PLA CPT[®] code for BLOODchip[®] ID Core XT[™], Grifols Diagnostic Solutions Inc. assay is 0084U; approved for use July 1, 2019.
