Re: HVAC shutdown – September 5, 2020

Background

On Thursday, September 3rd, we notified you that the air conditioning system had failed at the Tyler location. Fortunately, we were able to identify the cause; temporarily repair and restore air conditioning. However, a more permanent resolution is necessary and requires a planned complete shutdown of the heating, ventilation and air conditioning system (HVAC).

Impact to Client

The planned HVAC system shutdown will occur on Saturday, September 5th from 0700-1500. Only STAT orders will be filled during the shutdown in order to limit exposure of blood products to unacceptable temperatures. Once acceptable temperature is restored, normal ordering practices can resume.
