Re: UPDATE_Winter Storm and the Blood Supply

Update

Donor Center and Mobile drive operations in the North Texas area will remain closed Wednesday, February 1, 2023, due to inclement weather. Central Texas and East Texas operations will now also be closed. Impact to Clients and Client Action Required remain unchanged from the previous communication. The blood supply will be impacted by these closures and platelets and O negative red cells remain to be of particular concern.

Background

Carter BloodCare is actively monitoring the current winter weather event. Donor center and mobile drive operations in the North Texas area will be closed tomorrow January 31, 2023. East Texas and Central Texas locations will maintain normal operations at this time. Decisions affecting Wednesday, February 1, 2023, will be made accordingly. These closures will affect our operations and blood availability. Platelets are expected to be of particular concern later this week.

Impact to Clients

- Daily red cell and platelet stock orders could be triaged.
- If an order is needed for imminent transfusion, please communicate the urgency to hospital services.
- Red cell, platelet rotation, and standing orders will be re-scheduled or delayed.
- Hazardous driving conditions could delay blood product deliveries.

Client Action Required

- Be judicious when placing orders for products as current inventory levels do not support the ability to overstock red cells and platelets.
- Notify appropriate staff and medical director as applicable. Implement a triage process to help manage the supply.
- Please cooperate with hospital services as all blood orders may be triaged.
- Be prepared to release red cells or platelets to meet trauma and/or definite transfusion needs elsewhere as the blood center inventory may not be able to support.
- Please encourage family, friends and colleagues to donate blood.
